

Past Participle

Definition

- A past participle is a word that:
- is formed from a verb
 - is used as an adjective or for verb tense
 - probably ends **-ed, -d, -t -en** or **-n**.

Example



I have **forgotten** my lines.

verb tense
(from "to forget")

- It is important to learn and practice the correct conjugation of verbs to talk in past participle. For example, take a look at the next verb list on the 3rd column (the red one)

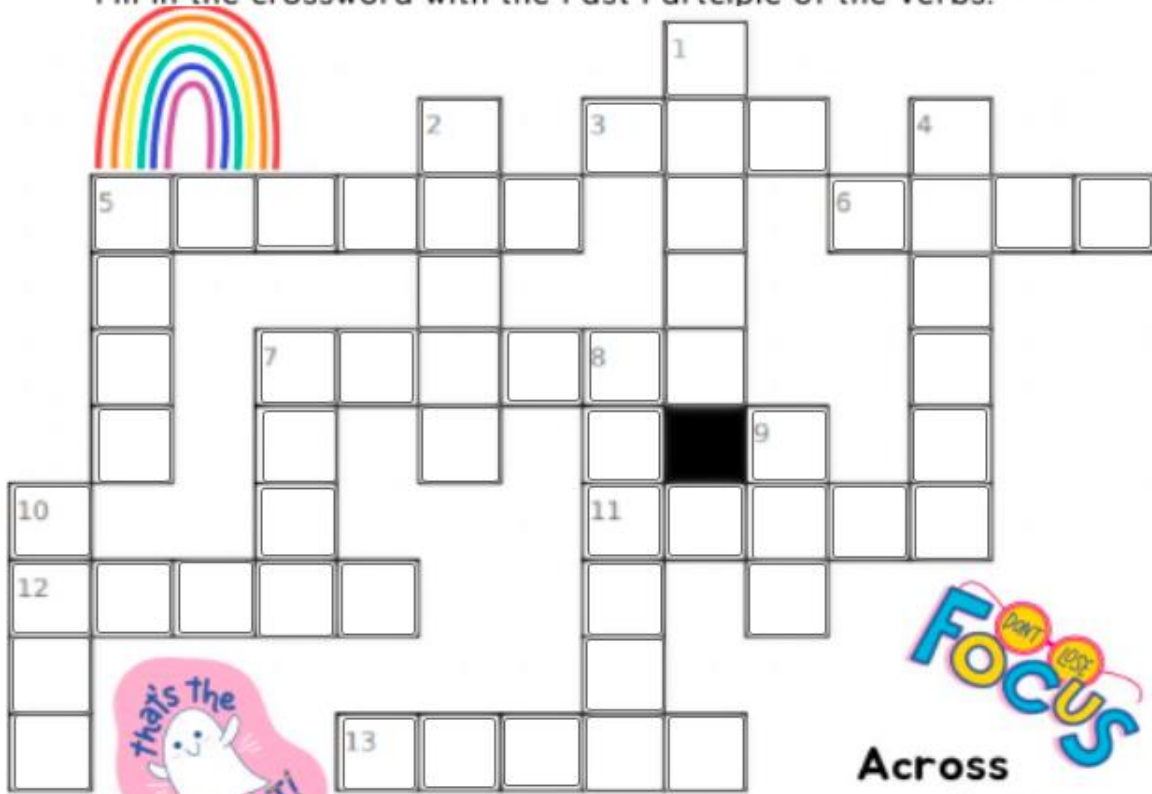
